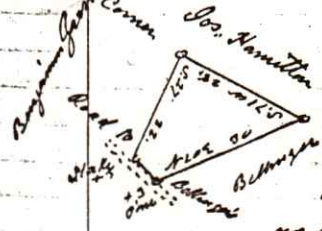

of Francis of Watkinson; in the County of Colleton and state of South Carolina of the second part: Whereas the County Auditor of each and every county in the state of South Carolina is authorized and required by an Act of the General Assembly of the state, entitled "An Act to amend an Act entitled An Act providing for the Assessment and Taxation of Property," passed September 15th 1868, and all Acts amendatory thereto, approved March 14, 1872, to execute a "Warranty Deed" to the purchaser or purchaser of all property forfeited to the state, under the provisions of the said Act providing for the Assessment and Taxation of property, and said other Acts amendatory thereto, and sold by the County Treasurer under the provisions of said Acts. Now, therefore, this Indenture witnesseth that J. John W. Burchidge County Auditor of the County of Colleton in the state aforesaid, of the first in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred and sixty three ²/₁₀₀ dollars, good and lawful money of the United States to me in hand paid by the said Francis G. Glover Sr. of the second part, for, and in behalf of the State of South Carolina, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Francis G. Glover Sr. all that certain lot, tract or parcel of land bounded and described as follows, to wit: Three thousand four hundred and fifty five and ⁷/₁₀₀ acres of land being three fifths of all that plantation tract of land known as the property of Dr. F. G. Glover bounded north by S & C R Road, South by L. C. Clifford's plantation east by Santee River and west by Deer Creek, sold at the same Tax sale to satisfy Taxes, costs and penalties due for the years 1868, 1869, 1870 and 1871

Together with all and singular the rights, members, servitudes, appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Francis G. Glover Sr. his heirs and assigns forever. And I John W. Burchidge County Auditor as aforesaid, do hereby bind the state of South Carolina, to warrant and force defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Francis G. Glover Sr. his heirs and assigns, against the said State of South Carolina, and against every person and all persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof. — Witness my hand and seal of the great seal of the state, this 21st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two, and in the 99th year of the Independence of the United States of America.
