Bischoff East by the Pin Pin River and lands late of Dr.
McPherson now of C.C. Clifford and West by Deer Creek, contain-
ing Twenty Eight Hundred acres more or less and particu-
larly described on a compiled plat of the West Bank Plantation
now on Pin Pin River taken from a copy of the survey by Mr
Wilson, said above described tract being contained in that
portion designated on said plat by the letters "A" "B" "Z" "D"
"H" "V" "U" "S" "B" "Z" "P" "O" "R" "T" "C" being a moiety of the said
West Bank Plantation formerly the property of Dr
Joseph Glover. Together with all the rights and appurte-
nances thereto belonging. To Have and to Hold all and
