The Will provides, inter alia:

"Also I give, derise and bequeath to my son Francis Y. Glover, M. D., the use of the whole of those my lands on Pon Pon Neck bounded to the East by Edisto River, to the West by Deer Creek, to the North and Northwest by Dr. Oswald and Mrs. B. Elliott, and to the South and Southwest by the Estates of McPherson and Morris and C. Jenkins, being composed of several tracks purchased of different persons (in a part of the High Land of which my wife helds a life estate): together with the use of my house and lot in which I now reside on the East side of Rutledge Street juring his natural life and after his death I will, devise and bequeath the same to his children, subject nevertidess to such Limitations over as shall be hereinafter expressed with respect to the remainder of my estate."

"Also I give, devise and bequeath to my five children, Ers. Sarah W. Waring, Hrs. Anna D. Legan, J. Edward Glover, M. D., 17s. E. S. Postell, and Francis Y. Glover, M. D., to each the use of an equal portion of the remainder of my estate both real and personal of whatsoever kind and wheresoever found of which I may die possessed during their natural lives to be divided equally between them, share and share alike, and after their deaths I give, devise and bequeath their several portions or shares to their children severally on their arriving at the age of twenty-one years in fee simple, to them, their heirs and assigns forever.

Provided Nevertheless that in the event of either of my aforesaid children dying and leaving no issue then in that case I will that the share or shares of my child or children so dying and leaving no issue shall be subject to his, her or their disposal by their last Will and Testament, and if one of my daughters, as though she were a femme sole and the power is hereby given unto them. Also I will that if either of my said children should die intestate and leave no issue, or leaving issue they should die under age, I in that event, give, devise and bequeath the use of his or their portions or shares to the survivor or survivors of those my children just named, subject nevertheless to the same limitations over as have been already expressed with respect to their own several and respective portions of my estate devised and bequeathed to tiem."
