ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate near the Town of Jacksonboro, County of Colleton, State of South Carolina, containing three hundred twenty five (325) acres, more or less, and being designated as Parcel M on a plat of Dear Creek Ranch prepared by S. S. Snook, R.L.S. dated December 12, 1957, revised by S. S. Snook, R.L.S. on June 18, 1959 and further revised by W. Gene Whetsell, R.L.S. No. 3131 in November, 1984, said plat being recorded April 17, 1986 in Plat: Book 25, Page 2 in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Colleton County, South Carolina.
